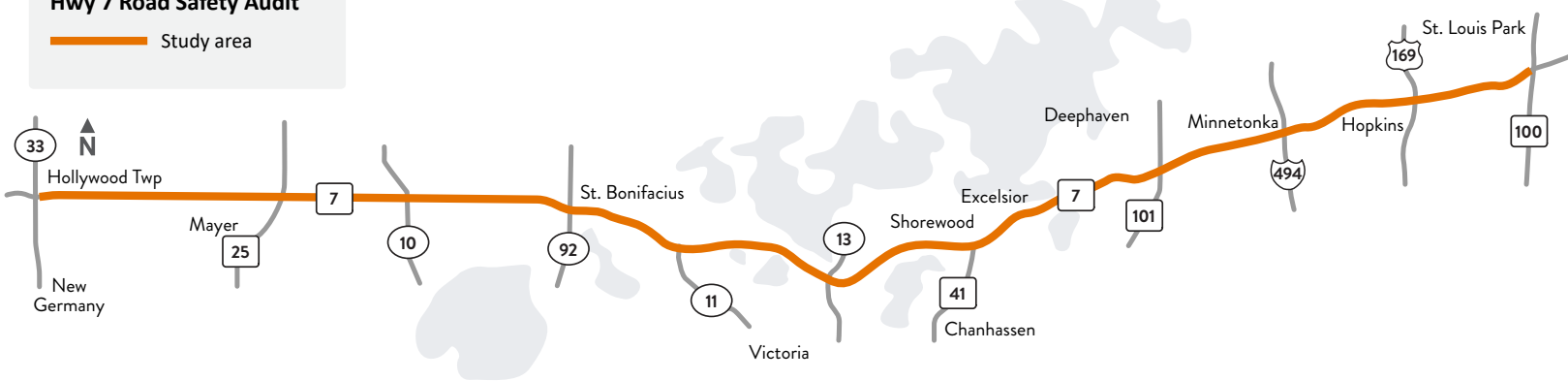


## Hwy 7 Road Safety Audit

## PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) is conducting a road safety audit of Hwy 7 between Hwy 100 in St. Louis Park and the western boundary of Carver County. A road safety audit is an evaluation of planned and existing roads that includes a review of crash history, prior plans and recommendations, and existing conditions to identify potential future safety projects.

## WHAT WILL BE STUDIED DURING THE ROAD SAFETY AUDIT?

During the Hwy 7 road safety audit, MnDOT will look for potential safety hazards that may affect any type of road user and suggest solutions to mitigate those safety issues. This includes:

- ✓ Evaluating roadside features, design elements and local conditions
- ✓ Observing the ways road users interact with the road
- ✓ Determining if the needs of all road users are being met safely
- ✓ Reviewing operational trends

## WHAT IS THE GOAL OF THE HWY 7 ROAD SAFETY AUDIT?

The goal of the Hwy 7 road safety audit is to identify potential future projects and strategies that could be implemented to improve the safety of all road users.
