Renewal of Refuse Hauler Contract

The City of Excelsior will be renewing refuse and recycling services with Republic Services. The new contract will begin on April 1, 2022 and Republic Services will be responsible for billing refuse and recycling services to residents. This change will save City staff time and help build a stronger relationship between residents and Republic Services.

Historically, refuse and recycling charges have appeared on your City utility bill. In April 2022, you will receive a City Utility Bill that has charges for refuse and recycling services provided in January, February, and March 2022. This will be the last time these charges are shown on your City utility bill.

Republic Services will also be sending an invoice in early April that will cover services provided in April, May, and June 2022. After this quarterly bill, residents will not receive another invoice from Republic Services until July.

Organics Recycling services will also be available to residents for an additional cost beginning April 1.

Dog Licensing

Per the Excelsior City Code Chapter 6, Section 6-3 - All dogs over the age of six months must obtain an animal license. Applications can be completed online or at City Hall. Payment of \$25 before April 1 or \$30 after April 1 can be mailed or dropped off to Excelsior City Hall at 339 Third Street or you can call 952-474-5233 with payment information.



Parking Permits

Each household is allowed to purchase parking stickers for vehicles registered to their Excelsior address. A parking permit allows residents to park at meters in Excelsior without having to pay the meter. Each parking sticker is \$20.00.

Permits may be purchased at City Hall during regular office hours and you **MUST** bring the registration (annual tab renewal) for each vehicle.

Trees in Excelsior

Excelsior loves its trees! Our large mature trees contribute to Excelsior's beauty and high quality of life. Protecting trees is a high priority for the City. Landmark Trees are 30" or greater in diameter. Landmark Trees may not be removed unless it is determined by an arborist that the tree is diseased or poses a safety risk. Significant trees are 8" or greater in diameter and the City protects these trees, though in certain circumstances removal is an option.

Tree removal permits are required to remove a tree. Please contact the City if you plan to remove a tree.

Residential Review Permits

Excelsior has a diverse collection of single-family homes that contribute to the unique small-town character that makes the city a desirable place to live. The City adopted the Residential Review Ordinance in October 2020 to ensure new residential development preserves and enhances that special character. A Residential Review Permit is required for the construction of any new single-family home, and for additions or remodeling that result in a larger home, reorient the home or changes the setbacks. The Excelsior Planning Commission uses the Good Neighbor Guidelines to evaluate projects. The Guidelines ensure that new construction is compatible with surrounding homes and regulates the mass and scale of the home. The Guidelines also preserve the views and privacy of adjacent properties. To date, the Planning Commission has reviewed 17 Residential Review Permit applications. The Good Neighbor Guidelines and the permit application can be found on the City's website under Planning.
