

339 THIRD STREET PROPOSED REDEVELOPMENT UPCOMING MEETING TIMELINE

The 339 Third Street/West Lot redevelopment has completed sketch plan review. The next step in the application process is preliminary Planned Unit Development (PUD) review, which is tentatively scheduled for the October 24th Planning Commission meeting and the November 7th City Council meeting. SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS

Final round of delinquent utility bill notices went out in July. Any delinquent bills not paid by September 1st will be assessed to property taxes for 2023 as a special assessment. The Public Hearing for delinquent accounts will be held September 19th, 2022. If your bill is scheduled to be assessed, you will get a public hearing notice.

Parking Impact Fees and Parking Lot Maintenance Fees for 2022 went out in July. They are due September 1st. Any unpaid fees will be assessed to property taxes for collection in 2023.

FALL CLEAN-UP

As you tend to your yard this fall, take a minute to sweep or rake leaves and grass clippings out of the street in front of your home. Left in the street, they can clog storm drains, contributing to localized flooding. When washed into nearby lakes and wetlands via storm drains or ditches, the leaves and clippings become a major source of phosphorus, the nutrient that feeds algae blooms in the summer. Dispose of leaves and grass clippings by composting them in your yard or take advantage of the upcoming Fall Yard Waste Cleanup event to ensure these organics are disposed of properly.

THC PRODUCTS IN EXCELSIOR

At its August 15th meeting, the City Council considered an ordinance regulating the sale of THC Products in the City of Excelsior. THC – which stands for Tetrahydro cannabinoid – is the psychoactive compound found in both hemp and marijuana. The sale of THC Products was legalized by the state legislature effective July 1 of this year.

Excelsior’s new ordinance will require any person selling THC Products in Excelsior to obtain a license from the City. In addition to requiring licensees to comply with state law, licensees will also be required to verify the age of any person purchasing THC Products to ensure that the products are not sold to persons under the age of 21. There will be a limited number of licenses available. Off-sale liquor stores will not be eligible to obtain a license. The ordinance also requires regular compliance checks that will be funded by the license fees. Violations of the ordinance will result in fines and/or suspension/revocation of the license to sell.
